His undergraduate degree is from Dallas Christian College, where he was named Valedictorian and received the Delta Epsilon Chi Award. At DTS, he received his ThM in 1996 and PhD in 2008.

Mark regularly presents at academic gatherings and conferences on biblical and pastoral themes, including such places as Camp of the Woods, Maranatha Conference Center, Mount Hermon, Billy Graham Training Center at The Cove, and Word of Life. He has published in various magazines and has written several books, including *How to Read the Bible Like a Seminary Professor* and the recently released *Jonah: Beyond the Tale of a Whale*. Mark is also an accomplished musician, having co-authored and recorded multiple songs and albums.
